Embrace the colorful atmosphere at Ballarò market and, after that, have a multiethnic lunch in Moltivolti, a social enterprise and a restaurant. There you will have the opportunity to discuss with local people on the social issues of the city, from the mafia to the challenges of the poor areas

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Corleone beyond the Godfather

The name "Corleone" is not simply that of a Godfather. Discover this picturesque village in the middle of the Sicilian countryside, enjoy the warm hospitality of the people and their effort to struggle against the Mafia.

This little town call to mind the violence of the Mafia: the real one, connected to the names of the 'Boss of all bosses' Totò Riina, and the fictional one, related to the the Godfather movies. But with us you will see the real Corleone, beyond the stereotypes.

The guided tour will retrace the history of Corleone from the late nineteenth century, when the Peasant struggle was the only form of Anti-mafia resistance. The tour runs through the city center and climbs up to wonderful panoramic viewpoints, where you can enjoy the beauty of the Sicilian countryside. It also includes the 'Laboratory of Legality'. Here you can admire the works of the Sicilian painter Gaetano Porcasi, which focus on the history of the Mafia and the Anti-mafia movement in Corleone.

In the afternoon, taste a good glass of LiberaTerra wine produced in the land confiscated from the Mafia: a concrete support to the legal economy.

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Zingaro trek & swim

Zingaro is the first Natural Oriented Reserve of Sicily, established in 1981 after many associations protested against the overbuilding of the area. The protests of the public opinion, and a march of 3000 people, succeeded in saving this 7 km of wild mediterranean coastline that extends from Castellammare to San Vito lo Capo.

Coming from the south entrance (Scopello gate) we will be walking in the wild nature of the Mediterranean coast to learn about the unique history, the fauna and the flora of the Zingaro reserve and then, we will take a swim in the light blue water of the famous "calette".

After a stop for a pic nic, prepared by Cotti in Fragranza, a social enterprise and an inclusion projects for guys with poor and difficult background, we will walk up to the north gate (San Vito entrance).

Once in San Vito Lo Capo, we could have an optional stop for a walk or to Taste the typical "caldofreddo" icecream.

Duration: FULL DAY – from 8.00 AM to about 7 PM
